

PUBLIC NOTICE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Board of Trustees of the Village of Bellport will hold a public hearing on the 25th day of January, 2010, at 7:00pm, at the Community Center, 4 Bell Street, Bellport, New York, to consider the adoption of a Local Law as follows:

LOCAL LAW NO. _____ OF 2010

A LOCAL LAW REPEALING THE PRESENT TEXT OF VILLAGE
CODE § 4-92 AND ENACTING NEW TEXT FOR
VILLAGE CODE § 4-92

BE IT ENACTED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF BELLPORT AS
FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. PURPOSE.

The purpose of this local law is to clarify the lawful reach of Village Code chapter 4 Article V.

SECTION 2. REPEAL OF VILLAGE CODE § 4-92.

Village Code § 4-92 in its present text is repealed.

SECTION 3. AMENDMENTS

Village Code § 4-92 as repealed is replaced by the following new text:

Persons who are fishing or crabbing at the eastern or seawardmost portion of the main dock shall use an identification card issued by the Village Clerk. Said card may be used by guests and family members of the person issued the card in accordance with any use policy hereafter enacted from time to time by resolution of the Board of Trustees.

SECTION 4. SEQRA

This is Type II action under 6 NYCRR § 617.5 (2) (27).

SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY.

Should any part or provision of this local law be decided by the courts to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the local law as a whole nor any part thereof other than the part so decided to be unconstitutional or invalid.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State as provided by law.

All persons in interest will be heard by the Board of Trustees at the public hearing to be held as aforesaid and may appear in person or by representative. The Community Center is accessible to handicapped person.
