MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION & APPLICATION

The South Bay Art Association (SBAA) was founded in 1958 to encourage the creation and appreciation of the visual arts. Anyone with a genuine interest in either goal is welcome to join the Association as an exhibiting member or as a non-exhibiting associate.

Throughout the year, SBAA members and friends enjoy a wide variety of programs including demonstrations by outstanding artists in many media. These provide a forum for critiques and exchange of ideas. Meetings are usually held on the fourth Wednesday of the month at 7:15pm in the Bellport Community Center at 4 Bell Street.

SBAA activities include workshops led by successful artists in a wide range of media and topics; there is a fee for workshop participation. The weekly sketch group meets outdoors during the summer, and indoors (with a clothed model) the remaining months of the year; a small fee is requested to pay the model. All members receive the monthly newsletter listing local art events, calls for artists, and gallery and other exhibit opportunities.

All exhibiting members are encouraged to display their work at the annual Members' Exhibit held over the Memorial Day weekend. Judges award ribbons in various categories. There is a fee for entering work but SBAA collects no commission on sales negotiated between artists and buyers.

Artists on the Lane is held on Independence Day in July. This popular and well attended event welcomes regional artists to display and sell their works of fine art along Bellport Lane. (There is a fee for space, but no commissions.)

The Juried High School Art Students Scholarship Exhibition is held annually in November. Judges award art scholarships to promising college-bound high school seniors. Donations to the scholarship fund are appreciated.
